- 1. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE THE MTFCA, ITS CHAPTERS, REGIONS OR SPECIAL INTEREST GROUPS, THEIR EMPLOYEES, OFFICERS AND AGENTS ("Releasees") from all liability to the undersigned, his or her or their personal representatives, assigns heirs, family members, and next of kin ("Releasors") for any negligent act or omission or other fault of the Releases or otherwise while the undersigned is participating in the Event or using any of **Releases'** facilities in connection with the Event.
- 2.
