Presidents report part 2

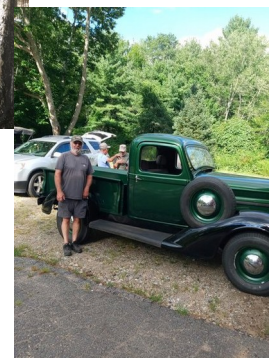
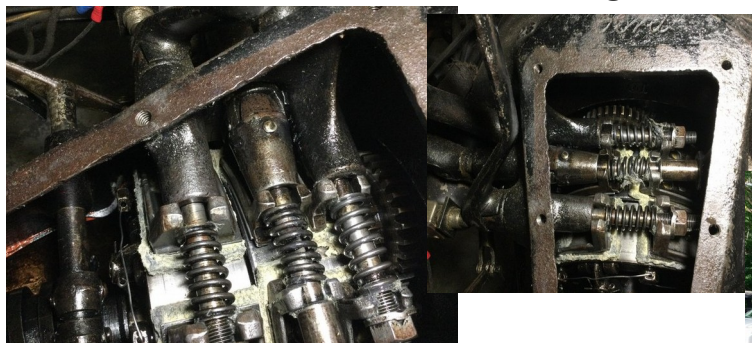
